ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING

CALL TO ORDER

The Chair called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

PRESENT

APPROVAL ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING MINUTES, APRIL 22-27, 2026

The Chair moved that the draft minutes of the April 22-27 Electoral Board meeting be tabled until the next meeting of the Electoral Board. The motion was seconded by the Secretary and when the question was called, the motion passed unanimously.

APPROVAL OF INVITATIONS TO SIMULTANEOUS FILING CANDIDATES

The DE/GR presented drafts of letters of invitation to candidates to attend a meeting on June 17, 2026, related to candidates that had filed simultaneously for office. The Chair moved the letters be sent as written to the appropriate candidates for office. The Vice Chair seconded the motion and when the question was called, the motion passed unanimously.

ADOPTION OF PROPOSED HOURS OF OPERATION FOR SUNDAY EARLY VOTING

The DE/GR shared with the Electoral Board an analysis of the personnel hours, costs, and options for hours of operation related to early voting on the second and third Sundays prior to Election Day. This is a new unfunded mandate now required by the Code of Virginia effective July 1, 2026, requiring early voting on the second and third Sundays prior to Election Day. The DE/GR options for hours of operation were provided to the Electoral Board. After discussion, the Chair moved that the hours of operation for Sunday early voting match Fairfax County and be promulgated for 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the required Sundays prior to Election Day. The Vice Chair seconded the motion and when the question was called, the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

The Electoral Board, at Electoral Board member expense, provides a combination of coffee, donuts, and pastries to each City precinct on Election Day. Officer of election (OE) desire for coffee has changed over the years. In response to this change, the Chair moved that the Electoral Board adjust its support of OE




