City of Fairfax Tropical Storm Safety Checklist



Tropical Storm Watch

- Tropical storm conditions with sustained winds from 39 to 73 mph are possible in your area within the next 48 hours.
- Monitor NOAA Weather Radio or local radio/TV weather broadcasts and be prepared to take protective measures should a warning be issued.
- ☐ Review your communication and evacuation plans.
- ☐ Make sure you have disaster supply kits available.

- ☐ Secure or bring inside any loose items that could be affected by high winds or flood waters.
- ☐ Secure doors and windows.
- ☐ Ensure all storm drains are clear and free of debris.
- ☐ Make sure vehicles are full of fuel and under cover if at all possible.
- Continue to monitor your NOAA Weather Radio or local radio/TV weather broadcasts for updated information.

Tropical Storm Warning

- Tropical storm conditions are expected in the warned area within the next 48 hours.
- ☐ Take protective measures immediately and seek shelter.
- ☐ Evacuate if instructed to do so.
- ☐ If time permits, complete watch checklist actions.
- ☐ Take shelter in a basement or a small windowless interior room, hallway, or closet on the lowest level of a sturdy building is the safest alternative.
- ☐ Stay away from windows and doors until the tropical storm warning has expired.
- Stay alert for the possibility of flooding, tornadoes, and severe thunderstorms.
- ☐ Continue to monitor your NOAA Weather Radio or local radio/TV weather broadcasts for updated information.
