Green Acres Parking Permit REQUIRED

A Green Acres parking permit is required for the street, upper/lower lots, and the circle Monday-Friday, 7am - 4pm. All who park must display the parking permit on their windshield. Visitors: please sign the Guest Parking Log at the Front Desk. Parking enforcement will monitor the area and tickets will be issued if a Parking Permit is not visible. The new Parking Permits are ORANGE and are FREE to Senior Center members with a membership card. Passes no longer have an expiration date. Sign up NOW at the Front Desk to get yours!



Fastran Transportation to Fairfax City Senior Center

Fastran offers specialized transportation services for residents of Fairfax County and the Cities of Fairfax and Falls Church

participating in human services agency programs. Transportation is provided to and from Fairfax City/County Senior Centers by approval. City residents can apply for bus service to our Senior Center activities by request at the Senior Center. An application must be filled

out to request service, which is typically available Monday-Friday from 9am -2pm, based on availability by Fastran. Fairfax County residents will be taken to the closest Senior Center to their residence (it may not be the Fairfax City Senior Center). Should it be necessary to cancel your scheduled trip, please contact the Fastran Cancellation Line at 703-324-7068 or Senior Center staff.

On Monday mornings you can **Walk** inside our climate-controlled gymnasium. There's **Aerobic Dancing** with Sharon Allen and **Line Dancing** and **Clogging** with Martha Hemingway.

Martha has added a new evening class- **Line Dancing to Country, Pop, & Oldies Music** class on **Thursdays** at 7:30p.m. – 8:30 p.m. Get some exercise, work your brain, hear good music, and have fun! Learn basic line dance steps like the grapevine, shuffle, and rocking chair. Several routines will be taught during each class to country, pop, and oldies music. No partner necessary. **Fee**: Session A - \$60 Session B - \$40 Drop-in - \$10.

Newcomers Pickleball - for people that are new to pickleball

Starting in September, Green Acres will host a pickleball workshop in the gym for seniors who are new to or learning the sport of pickleball. These workshops will take place on the first Friday of each month in the gym. The first session will be **Friday**, **September 6 at 11:30am**.

Workshops will be led by senior pickleball players who have offered to volunteer. They will answer questions and provide demonstration of the basics of pickleball and discuss how pickleball works at Green Acres.

Volunteers will briefly demonstrate dinking, discuss the non-volley zone (kitchen) and how pickleball differs from tennis. They will play a game (or part of a game) and will touch on the basics of scoring. Nets will be set up in the gym and newcomers are encouraged to participate and start playing around with dinking, serving, and returning serves. Bring your paddle and water bottle. We do have paddles available to loan as well.

Register Early for 2024 NVSO

Online registration opened Monday, July 1 for the 2024 Northern Virginia Senior Olympics which will take place Sept. 14-29. Participants must be 50 years of age by Dec. 31, 2024, and live in one of the sponsoring jurisdictions including the cities of Alexandria, Fairfax and Falls Church and the counties of Arlington, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun and Prince William.

Registration fee is \$20 which covers a multitude of events. Additional fees are required for 10 pin bowling, orienteering, cycling and 9 hole, 3 par golf. Most events are offered in five- and 10-year age groups and by gender. Registration is online only at www.nvso.us. The full event schedule, rules plus photos and results from 2023 are also on the website. For more specific information or to be a volunteer, contact nvso1982@gmail.com.

Riley Geary, NVSO committee chair said, "There are 83 events offered which will take place at 26 different venues throughout Northern Virginia." Geary also said, "There are both indoor and outdoor events and some surprises such as crossword puzzles, sudoku, rummikub and bunco in addition to pickleball, track, field, swimming, tennis and much more."

All events are open to the public and family and friends of the participants are welcome to come
