GENERAL INFORMATION TRADITIONAL & SPECIALTY CAMPS

PAYMENTS

Once you are registered for a camp program, you may choose a payment plan or pay in full. If you select to use a payment plan, it is required to setup the automatic payment plan with a credit card to be held on file.

- A deposit of \$100 for Traditional Camps or \$50 per Specialty Camp will be due at the time of enrollment of camps.
- Payments will be charged on April 1, May 1, and June 1.

Staff reserve the right to remove your child from the camp program for any outstanding payments.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

We strive to provide access to all programs regardless of financial status. Financial Assistance is available for qualified **FAIRFAX CITY** residents only. Tax forms and/or proof of income are required. Financial aid will be based on a sliding scale. If you wish to apply for financial assistance, please contact us to make an appointment. Re-application is required every year.

Deadline for financial assistance for the camp program is June 1.

NEW CANCELLATION, REFUNDS, AND TRANSFERS

Cancellations and Refunds: To request a refund, a Refund Request Form must be completed and emailed to camps@fairfaxva.gov

Before May 1st:

If you submit your Refund Request Form prior to May 1st you will be issued a full refund.

CANCELLATION, REFUNDS, AND TRANSFERS CONTINUED...

May 2nd-June 1st:

Refund Requests submitted between May 2 and June 1 will be issued a full refund minus your deposit.

No refunds will be given after June 1.

Please review your summer plans to ensure that if you need to cancel out of a camp you have submitted your Refund Request Form by June 1st. The only exception to this policy is a documented illness or family emergency.

During Camp:

Refunds will not be issued for any missed program days within a camps scheduled sessions due to changed work or vacation schedules, sick days or other non-emergency reasons, or if a camper is sent home early or suspended from attending camp in accordance with the Parent Handbook.

Please note: If a camper cannot finish camp once it begins due to a medical condition, a doctor's note is required within 24 hours for a pro-rated refund. Requests received after the camp session ends will not be granted.

Transfers:

Due to program minimums, transfers MUST be requested at least 14 days prior to the first day of the camp session from which you are withdrawing. Multiple transfers may be subject to a \$25 processing fee.

**Fairfax City reserves the right to cancel a camp if we believe it is in the best interest of participant health and safety. All individuals registered for a canceled camp program will receive a full refund of the registration fee.

WAITLISTS

Traditional Day Camps:

We will maintain a waitlist on a first-come, first-served basis.

If a spot opens up, the Parks and Recreation staff will contact the waitlist in order to fill the spot.

Specialty Camps:

Any open spots will be released each Thursday at 12 noon and will remain open until filled.

After June 1, we will maintain a first-come, first serve waitlist for specialty camps.

HEALTH PROFILE

Once registered, all parents or guardians must complete a health profile on campdoc.com for their camper in order to attend camp. This includes all emergency contacts, health history, pickup authorizations and other important information for camp staff to keep your child as safe as possible. If your child attended camp previously, you will need to go in and update or approve previous information.

Children will not be permitted to attend camp without a completed profile.

REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS

The City of Fairfax is committed to the letter and spirit of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If your child has a disability or requires special attention for any reason, advanced notice is required to make accommodations. Welcome

We are excited to welcome your campers this summer! Please review the following information about our policies before registering for camp.

AFTER CARE

After care is available at Daniels Run, Providence and Katherine Johnson Camps. Camps will offer LIMITED spaces in extended care from 4-6pm daily. Registration can be done weekly or daily (depending on space). See camp information for fees.

STAFF

The City of Fairfax Parks and Recreation Department takes tremendous pride in our amazing camp staff. Many of our camp employees have worked in our camp program for several years. Each camp has a Site Director who manages the program. Specialists in areas of art and sports will visit each site every week to teach different activities. Each camp site has personnel who are trained in standard First Aid and hold a current CPR and AED certification. In order to provide the best care for your child, all staff are required to attend trainings before and throughout the summer.

FIELD TRIPS

The costs of the field trips are incorporated into the price of the camp. Please see the specific camp description for more details on each field trip specifics. Field trip calendars will be released by April 2026.

DISCOUNTS

Discounts MUST be applied at the time of registration. **NO discounts will be applied after registration.**

You will be prompted to enter your code during the checkout process.

Full Payment Discount

A full payment discount of \$50 is available to anyone who pays in full at the time of registration for FULL SUMMER traditional day camp registrations.

CODE: FULL

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount will be applied for families registering for traditional camp with two or more children in the same household. A discount of \$50 off each child in a family of two or more. *Qualifiers: A sibling is categorized as 'one of two or more individuals having one or both parents in common.'*

All accepted families will receive an email prior to the start of camp with details about their specific camp site.

Information Session

A virtual information session will be held in the beginning of June for all registered camp families.

Families will have the opportunity to meet some of the camp staff, learn more about the camp day, and ask questions. We highly recommend you attend this session, but it is not mandatory.

Preschoolers and rising kindergartners can enjoy the summer at the Little School Summer Camp! This camp will provide children with age-appropriate activities that will include arts and crafts, entertainers, games, and water play (there are no swimming pool activities). Children will develop important social skills while playing with their friends and leaders in a fun and safe environment. The camp will be broken up into groups based on age, campers will be required to be in the appropriate age group. Campers registered for the wrong age group will be removed.

Requirements for Little School Camp

The Little School Summer Camp is a Virginia state-licensed preschool program.

Requirements for ALL Little School Summer Camp Participants:

- Campdoc.com online 'Health Profile' 100% complete
- Proof of age verification: birth certificate or current passport
- VA State School Entrance Health Form - must be signed by the doctor (This includes a physical examination within 12 months prior to starting the camp program and immunization records dated within one year of attendance)

An open house will be held in June for all Little School Camp families where paperwork will be turned in.

If the paperwork is not received, the City of Fairfax reserves the right to withdraw participants from the program. Children will not be allowed to attend camp without all paperwork completed and submitted to staff.
