## Notes:

- The link on this step will take you to a page that outlines the County's full permitting process, which includes but is not limited to an application, background check, fingerprinting, proof of immunizations, first aid and CPR training, home health and safety visit, training, and annual renewal.
- The Family Child Care Permit is issued by Fairfax County Neighborhood Community Services, division of Early Childhood Programs and Services. They are located in the Pennino Building at 12011 Government Center Parkway, 8th Floor Fairfax, VA 22035.
- Building, Zoning, and Trade Permits are not always required. Construction on the property to accommodate your childcare business can necessitate the need for permits. For more information on when permits are or are not required, or if you have questions, visit our [Permit FAQs page](#) or contact Code Administration using the info provided above.
- As part of the County's review process, they will inform you when it is time to schedule this cost-free annual inspection through the City, which is required in addition to the County's home health and safety inspection. To schedule the initial inspection, operators must call Code Administration at the phone number above. Code staff will contact operators proactively on an annual basis thereafter to schedule these. A copy of the inspection report is kept on file at the City and one copy is sent to the County's division of Early Childhood Programs and Services.
- Fairfax City Economic Development (FCED) is not located in City Hall. They are located in the WillowWood Plaza office complex at 10300 Eaton Place, suite 235.
