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### RE: Stream Restoration Project along an Unnamed Tributary of the Accotink Creek: Update

Dear Resident, Property Owner, or Homeowners Association Representative,

The City Council awarded a construction contract to Meadville Land Services, Inc. on November 12, 2019, for Phase I of the "Stream Restoration Project along an Unnamed Tributary of the Accotink Creek". Construction is expected to start in early-March 2020 and the project timeframe is 4 months. The limits of the Phase I stream restoration project will be from 10517 Center St/10600 Springmann Dr. east to the Chain Bridge Rd. bridge. We are currently discussing easement acquisition with property owners on the Phase II side of the project. Please see the map on the back of this letter for the project limits.
