REGISTRATION

To register for camp, you may register online or in person. To ensure proper placement of the camper, a birth certificate may be required before or after registration. Registration is first-come, first-served – limited space is available for each camp. If a camp is full, you'll be placed on a waitlist and contacted by the Parks and Recreation staff if a space becomes available.

2020 REGISTRATION START DATES

ONLINE REGISTRATION (Highly Recommended)

To register online, visit CampDoc.com. This registration system is compatible with Google Chrome, Firefox and Safari (not Internet Explorer).

Access to a computer system is necessary for completing the required documents to allow your child to attend camp.

If you registered for camp in 2017-2019, you will be able to login to your account with saved information. Review and approval of this information will be required.

PAYMENTS

Automatic Payment Plan

At the time of registration, you may choose to pay in full for the entire summer or choose a payment plan. If you choose to use a payment plan, it is required to enroll in the Automatic Payment Plan with a credit card to be held on file.

Payment Plan Schedule:

- A deposit of \$100 (full summer), \$25 (for each individual session) or \$25 per specialty camp will be due at the time of registration
- The remaining balance will be split into three equal payments. The card on file is charged monthly in March, April, and May. If registering after a payment date, the deposit and past payment amounts will be due at the time of registration. All registrations in May or later must be paid at full at the time of registration.

Failed Payments

If a payment fails to process on the due date, you will be notified. You will then have five business days to make the payment. If the payment is not paid after day five, there will be a \$50 fee incurred and a \$50 fee for every additional five days thereafter that the payment is outstanding.

Staff reserve the right to remove your child from the camp program for any outstanding payments overdue.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Financial Assistance is available for qualified **FAIRFAX CITY** resident families. Tax forms and/or proof of income are required, and financial aid will be based on a sliding scale. If you need to apply for financial assistance, you must contact the Fairfax City Parks and Recreation Department to make an appointment. Re-application is required every year for this program. **Deadline for financial assistance for the camp program is June 1.**

FORMS

All families must complete a profile for each new camper, which includes emergency contacts, health history and other important information for camp staff to keep your child as safe as possible. For returning families, your information from 2019 is saved in the system but it will be **REQUIRED** that a parent/guardian reviews their CampDoc profiles to confirm that there are no changes in contact information, medical information or emergency contact information.


To review this information, you'll need to log in to your child's account from the previous year and, when prompted, indicate that there are not changes that need to be made. This should be completed **AFTER** your child is registered for camp. All new families must complete a profile for each new camper, which includes emergency contacts and health history, among other important info. Your camper's profile must be completed by **NO LATER** than June 1.

Children will not be permitted to be dropped off at camp without a completed profile. This process can only be completed through our CampDoc site.

WAITLISTS

Some of our camps are very popular and fill very quickly. We maintain a waitlist on a first-come, first-served basis.

If a spot opens up, the Parks and Recreation staff will contact the waitlist in order to fill the spot. Please understand we do all we can to get as many kids enrolled in camp, so be patient and we will let you know if something becomes available.

Registration for Returning Participants who attended the 2019 Summer Camp starts Monday, February 10, 2020

2020 Summer Camp registration for campers who participated in the 2019 City of Fairfax Summer Camp (and their siblings) will begin on **Monday, February 10, 2020**. If you register before February 24, you are guaranteed a space in the program.

Open Registration for All New Summer Camp Participants 2020: Starts Monday, February 24, 2020

Starting on **Monday, February 24, 2020** we will accept registrations for new campers who did not participate in the 2019 camp program.



DISCOUNTS

All discounts will be applied at the time of registration – please be sure to enter the code when prompted while registering.

Full Payment Discount

A discount of \$50 will be applied if the registration is paid in FULL at the time of registration BEFORE March 1, for the FULL Summer option for any of the Traditional Day Camps.

AT REGISTRATION USE COUPON CODE TO APPLY DISCOUNT: "FULL"

Sibling Discount

A sibling discount will be applied for families registering for camp with two or more children in the same household. A discount of \$50 off the FULL summer registration is given for each child in a family of two or more. Qualifiers: A sibling is categorized as one of two or more individuals having one or both parents in common.

REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS

To request a refund, a Refund Request Form must be completed. This form can be found at fairfaxva.gov/parksrec. If approved, refunds will be processed – minus a \$100 fee – for the full summer or \$25 for each withdrawn session. No refunds will be given after June 14. Space permitting, transfers into different sessions will be allowed and a transfer fee of \$20 will be charged for each transaction.

STAFF

The City of Fairfax Parks and Recreation Department take tremendous pride in our amazing camp staff. Many of our camp employees have worked in our camp program for several years. Each venue has a Site Leader who manages the camp. Specialists in areas of art and sports will visit each site every week to teach different activities. Each camp site has personnel who are trained in standard First Aid and hold a current CPR and AED certification. In order to provide the best care for your child, all staff is required to attend trainings before and throughout the summer.

FIELD TRIPS

The costs of the field trips are incorporated into the price of the camp. Please see the specific camp description for more details on each on field trip specifics.

Field-trip calendar for each camp will be posted online and emailed to all registered camp participants in April 2020.

Requirements for Sunshine Kidz Camp Program

The Sunshine Kidz Day camp Program is a Virginia state-licensed preschool program. These forms will be available in all offices and online.

Requirements for ALL Sunshine Kidz Day Camp Participants:

- Campdoc.com online profile 100% complete
- Proof of age verification (birth certificate or current passport)
- VA State School Entrance Health Form – must be signed by the doctor (This includes a Physical examination within 12 months prior to starting the camp program and immunization records dated after 8/7/19)

ALL Participants of Sunshine Kidz are required to hand in the proof of age and health form in on one of the following days to the Sherwood Center, 3740 Old Lee Highway, Fairfax:

- **Tuesday, May 12, 4:30 - 7 pm**
- **Wednesday, May 20, 9 am - 1 pm**
- **Friday, May 29, 3 - 5 pm**

If the paperwork is not received, the Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to withdraw participants from the program. Children will not be allowed to attend camp without all paperwork completed and handed in to staff. If registering after May 29th, all completed paperwork is required at the time of registration.

If registering after a payment date, the deposit and past payment amounts will be due at the time of registration.

Full payment is due if registering for a specialty camp after May 1st. Please see failed payment policy on page 3.

To request a refund, a Refund Request Form must be completed. If approved, refunds will be processed minus a \$25 fee for each specialty camp session. No refunds will be given seven days before the start of the camp. The Fairfax City Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to accept or decline a refund request.

Low Enrollment:

The Fairfax City Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel Specialty Camps due to low enrollment or other extenuating circumstances. Registered participants will be notified via email or phone call, seven days before the start date of the camp.
