## PUBLIC NOTICE

### March 3, 2020, Democratic Presidential Primary

The City of Fairfax will be holding a Democratic Primary to elect the office of President. Voting begins at 6:00 a.m. and ends at 7:00 p.m., on Tuesday, March 3, 2020.

### Voter Registration Deadlines

- You must register to vote 21 days or more before each election. The deadline to register to vote is February 10, 2020.
- Qualified persons who will be 18 years of age on or before November 3, 2020, are eligible to register to vote.
- You may register by mail or in-person at any Virginia Voter Registrar's Office. Other Government Agencies that you may obtain voter registration applications include public libraries, the United States Postal Service, and the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).
- You can register to vote online through the Virginia Department of Elections website: <https://www.elections.virginia.gov>.
- If you are a new registrant or have changed the information on your existing Virginia's voter registration, you will be sent a voter information notice by mail after you register.
- Your registration is permanent, so long as you continue to vote. You do not need to re-register for each election.
- You are required to notify the General Registrar of any change of name or address.

### Absentee Voting Deadlines

Absentee voting begins January 17, 2020, and ends February 29, 2020.

- Absentee voters may request an absentee ballot to be mailed by submitting the Absentee Ballot Applications. The deadline to submit the Absentee Ballot Applications is 5:00 p.m., February 25, 2020. Voters may submit the application to the Registrar's Office via mail or in-person.
- Absentee voters may vote in-person at the Registrar's Office from January 17, 2020, to January 29, 2020. The deadline to absentee vote in-person is 5:00 p.m., January 29, 2020.

### Location and Hours of Operations

The Registrar's Office is in Suite 300 on the 3rd floor of the City Hall's Annex building at 10455 Armstrong Street, Fairfax, VA 22030. Hours of operations are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays. The Registrar's office will also open during regular hours for in-person absentee voting on Saturday, February 29, 2020.

### Canvass of Votes Meeting

The Electoral Board will meet at 10:00 a.m., March 4, 2020, to begin the canvass of votes meeting and discuss provisional vote cases. The meeting will be held at the Registrar's Office. Because of the Voter ID requirements, provisional votes meeting may adjourn from day to day and not conclude as late as 12:00 p.m., Friday, March 6, 2020.
