**RE: Stream Restoration Project along an Unnamed Tributary of the Accotink Creek
Construction Starting Monday, March 2**

Dear Resident, Property Owner, or Homeowners Association Representative,

Meadville Land Service, Inc. is scheduled to begin construction of Phase I of the “Stream Restoration Project along an Unnamed Tributary of the Accotink Creek” on Monday, March 2, 2020, and the project timeframe is 4 months. Work hours are limited by the City’s noise ordinance to 7AM-6PM on weekdays and 8:30AM-5PM on Saturdays. Non-disruptive work may take place outside of those hours. Work may be postponed due to inclement weather or high flows in the stream after rainfall. Public Works has contracted with Wetland Studies & Solutions, Inc. to provide construction oversight and their inspector will be on-site while work is taking place.

The limits of the Phase I stream restoration project will be from 10517 Center St/10600 Springmann Dr east to the Chain Bridge Rd bridge and are shown on the map on the back of this letter.

Discussions with property owners for easements on the Phase II side are ongoing and we will send additional updates as this phase moves forward.
