PUBLIC NOTICE

November 3, 2020 Presidential Election

The City of Fairfax will be holding a General Election to elect the offices of President and Vice President of the United States, United States Senate, and the United States House of Representative (11th District). Voting begins at 6:00 a.m. and ends at 7:00 p.m., on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

Voter Registration Deadlines

- You must register to vote 21 days or more before each election. The deadline to register to vote is October 13, 2020.
- Qualified persons who will be 18 years of age on or before November 3, 2020, are eligible to register to vote.
- You may register by mail or in-person at any Virginia Voter Registrar's Office. Other Government Agencies that you may obtain voter registration applications include public libraries, the United States Postal Service, and the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV).
- You can register to vote online through the Virginia's Department of Elections website: <https://elections.virginia.gov>.
- If you are a new registrant or have changed the information on your existing Virginia's voter registration, you will be sent a voter information notice by mail.
- Your registration is permanent, so long as you continue to vote. You do not need to re-register for each election.
- You are required to notify the General Registrar of any change of name or address.

Absentee Voting Deadlines

Absentee voting begins September 18, 2020, and ends October 31, 2020.

- Absentee voters may request an absentee ballot to be mailed by submitting the Absentee Ballot Application. The deadline to submit the Absentee Ballot Application is 5:00 p.m., October 23, 2020. Voters may submit the application to the Registrar's Office via mail, in-person, or online through the Virginia's Department of Election website: <https://elections.virginia.gov>.
- Absentee voters may vote in-person at the Registrar's Office from September 18, 2020, through October 31, 2020. The deadline to absentee vote in-person is 5:00 p.m., October 31, 2020.

Location and Hours of Operations

The Registrar's Office is located at Suite 300 of the City Hall's Annex building at 10455 Armstrong Street, Fairfax, VA 22030. Hours of operations are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays. The Registrar's office will also open during regular hours for in-person absentee voting on Saturday, October 24 and October 31, 2020.

Provisional Ballots Meeting and Canvass of Results

The Electoral Board will meet at 10:00 a.m., November 4, 2020, to begin the provisional ballots meeting. Canvass of results begins when the provisional ballots meeting adjourned. The meeting will be held at the Registrar's Office. In subject to the Code of Virginia [§24.2-643](#) and [§24.2-709](#), provisional votes meeting may adjourn from day to day and not conclude as late as 5:00 p.m. Monday, November 9, 2020.
