Additional Project Description:	<p>Roberts Road is located in the City of Fairfax, Virginia. This project consists of construction of approximately 1,200 feet of sidewalk, curb, and gutter on the west side of the roadway between Main Street and Sager Avenue. Given the narrow width of the existing street, the addition of a new sidewalk, and necessary roadway features, easements from individual property owners will be required. The project consists of introducing a new sidewalk as described above to achieve a consistent typical section of two 11' travel lanes, 4' desired landscape strips, and a 5' minimum (6' desired) sidewalk. The existing shoulder along the west side will be removed and replaced with VDOT standard CG-6 concrete curb and gutter. Private driveways will be replaced with standard VDOT CG-9B or D, and standard CG-11 will be used for street connections. Sidewalk materials will be standard concrete.</p>
