Vision: The inspirational statement of Fairfax in 2035.


Guiding Principles: Content-specific inspirational statements.

Guiding Principle

Chapter 6: Community Services (Education)

In 2035, Fairfax is a city with world-class community schools and a best-in-class education from preschool to post high school that prepares students to be productive, responsible members of society, capable of competing in the global economy and motivated to pursue life-long learning.

Goal 1. Ensure the City's public education needs are met with excellent instructional services and superior facilities, geared to the needs of our changing and diverse population.

- Outcome 1.1. The City-County school agreement continues to provide City students with the highest quality education.
- <u>Outcome 1.2</u>. Public schools are appropriately sized with the latest technology and functional accommodations to meet the future needs of the school-aged population.
- **Outcome 1.3.** An education program that continues to benefit the City by providing variety and cost-effectiveness.

Goal 2. Ensure access to educational and training opportunities from early childhood throughout life by collaborating with local and nearby education providers and institutions.

- Outcome 2.1. A well-trained, qualified workforce.
- Outcome 2.2. An empathetic and informed community.
- Outcome 2.3. Partnerships and community resources that provide opportunities for training and continuing education.
