**City of Fairfax Electoral Board Policy for Notifying Political Parties of Their Ability
to Nominate Officers of Election**

PURPOSE:

To establish a policy wherein the City of Fairfax Electoral Board shall notify the Chair of the Democrat Party City Committee and the Chair of the Republican Party City Committee that the Code of Virginia, §24.2-115, allows political parties to nominate individuals to serve as Officers of Election for each election/primary in which the voters of the City of Fairfax cast ballots in accordance with Virginia Election Laws.


POLICY ESTABLISHMENT:

It is the policy of the Electoral Board that in the second week of December of each year the Electoral Board shall notify the Chair of the Democrat Party City Committee and the Chair of the Republican Party City that nominations for Officers of Election are to be filed with the Secretary of the Electoral Board at least 10 days before February 1 of each year.

ELECTORAL BOARD ADMINISTRATION OF PARTY NOMINATIONS OF OFFICERS OF ELECTION:

Nominations for Officers of Election submitted by the Chair of the Democrat Party City Committee and the Chair of the Republican Party City Committee to the Secretary of the Electoral Board shall be forwarded to the General Registrar/Director of Elections for appropriate screening and processing. Nominees of the political parties will be screened in the same manner as all other individuals who have applied to be Officers of Election.
